Mock Results Day

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Year 11 pupils who have now finished their Year 11 March Mock Exam series.

We'd like to remind you that Year 11 pupils will receive a mock results session on Wednesday 6th April 2022. During this, pupils will receive their mock result grades and have the opportunity of any mentoring they wish between 3:30pm and 4:20pm. There will also be a treat available for Year 11 pupils during this session as a reward for their hard work.

During the results session, pupils will receive the full copy of the Summer 2022 GCSE Exam Timetable so they can see when the exams are taking place. They will receive a personalised timetable after Easter. We recommend pinning this up somewhere visible at home so that pupils are aware of exactly when their exams are. This will help them to plan their revision timetable accordingly.

Easter Interventions

Year 11 interventions will take place in the Easter holidays and have been arranged to support pupils and help fill gaps in knowledge and / or complete controlled assessments, in the final push before the GCSE summer exam series. Proposed dates for these intervention sessions are Monday 11th to Thursday 14th April, and Tuesday 19th to Friday 22nd April 2022. We strongly recommend keeping these dates free so that pupils are available to attend all of the intervention sessions requested by their class teachers. Pupils will receive green clicks on Class Charts for their attendance.

Pupils will receive their individual Easter intervention timetables week commencing 4th April 2022.

English Literature Masterclass – Wednesday 20th April 2022

As part of the Easter intervention programme, the English Department have invited Stacey Reay into school to deliver an English Literature Masterclass. The event is targeted towards pupils aiming for Grades 7 - 9 in their GCSE English Literature exams and will be incredibly beneficial in supporting pupils with their revision skills and preparation for their exams.



Stacey Reay, who specialises in revision for AQA English, will be leading the sessions. The focus of the day will be the revision of two literature texts: 'An Inspector Calls' and 'A Christmas Carol'. Pupils will take part in a morning session from 10:00am to 12:00pm, and an afternoon session from 1:00pm to 3:00pm. Pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch and refreshments.

Year 11 Rewards

As you will know from our communication throughout the year, only pupils who have 92% or above on Class Charts are eligible to receive the Year 11 Leavers Rewards. If pupils need to know their Class Charts codes, they should email Miss Eldrington.

Leavers Hoodies

Pupils have received an email earlier this week from Miss Eldrington with a Forms link to complete; this is to choose which colour hoodie and size they would like. We will be cross checking Class Charts on Friday 25th March 2022 to check whether pupils are eligible. Once these arrive in school, pupils will be able to wear them as part of their uniform for their remaining time in school. Hoodies will be £20.00, and payment will be available on ParentMail once Class Charts has been cross checked.

Pupils will have the opportunity to continue to increase their Class Charts % before Leavers Day and Prom.

Leavers Date and Information

Year 11 Leavers Day 2022 will be after the final science GCSE exam on Thursday 23rd June 2022. There will be more detailed information closer to the time. The cut-off date for pupils to get to 92% for Leavers Day will be Friday 10th June 2022.

Prom Date and Information

Year 11 Prom 2022 will take place on Friday 8th July 2022 at Blackwell Grange Hotel, Darlington. More information will be released closer to the time. The cut-off date for pupils to get to 92% for Prom will be Thursday 23rd June 2022.

If pupils have any ideas for Leavers Day and Prom, please encourage them to share them with us on the Forms link that has been shared with them by email.
